

Senior Golfer Named AJGA All-American

Ravenscroft senior golfer **Ryan Gerard** has been named a First-Team Rolex Junior All-American, according to a press release by the American Junior Golf Association (AJGA) in October.

A UNC-Chapel Hill commit, Gerard is currently ranked eighth in the world among under-18 golfers in the latest AJGA rankings and is 298th in the World Amateur Rankings. Gerard is a two-time NCISAA All-State honoree, and was named TISAC Player of the Year three times and TISAC All-Conference five times. This is the first time Gerard has received the All-America honor.

Introduced by the AJCA in 1978, the Rolex Junior All-America Teams annually recognize players who have proven to be the world's premier junior golfers. This year's All-America Teams are comprised of 96 junior golfers ages 13-19 from both the United States as well as countries around the world. The teams were determined exclusively through the Polo Golf Rankings as of October 12.
