RALEIGH, NC -- Ravenscroft has earned the No. 3 seed in the NCISAA Boys Lacrosse Tournament, marking the third straight year that the team has received a Top 3 seed. The Ravens have received a first-round bye, and they will host the winner of the Forsyth Country Day vs. Cannon School game on Tuesday (May 12) in Raleigh.

Ravenscroft will enter the tournament riding a school record 12-game win streak. The Ravens completed the regular season with a 13-1 mark, and they won their fourth straight TISAC title. Ravenscroft is currently ranked second in the state overall by LaxPower.com.

The opening round of the tournament will be played on Friday with games played at the home site of the higher seed. The quarterfinals will be held on May 12, followed by the semifinals on May 14 and the championship game on Saturday, May 16.
